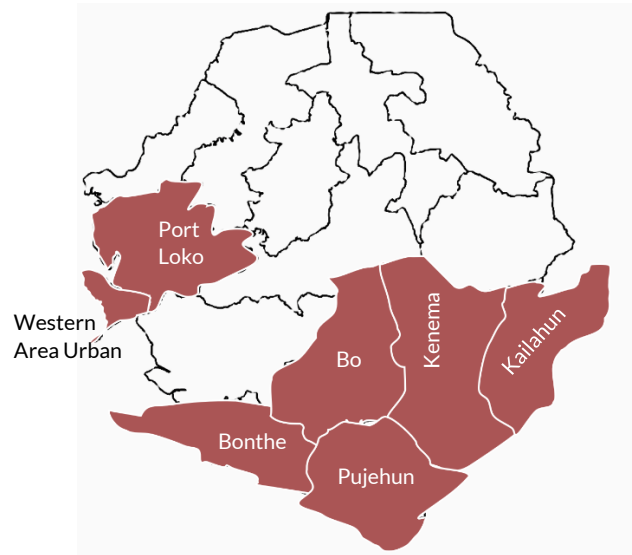


Save the Children Sierra Leone Country Profile

Operational Regions

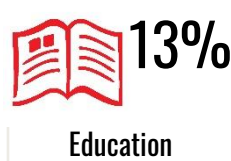
- Eastern Sierra Leone operations – **Kenema, Kailahun**

Recent Emergency Responses

- **Mabella** fire outbreak – Freetown. 302 household supported with food and non-food items and back to school supplies.
- **Koibeima village** fire outbreak – Pujehun district. 32 household supported with food and non-food items and back to school supplies.
- **Supported 800 households** with unconditional cash transfer in fourteen chiefdoms in **Pujehun district** in response to food insecurity.

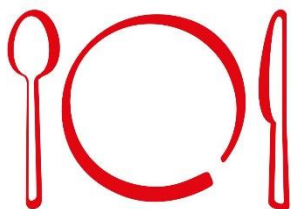
